Fellowship on the Lord's Move in Kenya

From 24 to 27 February, the responsible brothers in Kenya gathered together in Bahati, Kenya for prayer and fellowship on the Lord's move in Kenya. The brothers are very encouraged as well as burdened for the furtherance of the gospel in Kenya. We were all reminded of the great commission from the Lord: "Go therefore and disciple all the nations." (Matt. 28:19a) We have formed a team to oversee this matter and to come up with a schedule on how to go on from one city to another. We began the propagation in the city of Machakos (about 100 kilometers East of Nairobi). We thank the Lord that in seven weeks' time, a good number of people have turned to the Lord and to His Body. 10 people were baptised and entered into the kingdom of God. On 17 April 2022, the first bread-breaking meeting took place.



In addition, we are also shepherding Kenyans living overseas who are not yet meeting with us. There are currently 23 of these contacts who have been joining online times of fellowship. May the Lord nourish them and gain them for His recovery.

Young People

We thank the Lord for the times of fellowship concerning "Raising Up the Next Generation" in Africa. From the fellowship we have seen the burden and the need to have a thorough turn in our concept on how to carry out the work among the children and the young people (YP). We have been so helped in the matters of: (1) The role of parents – to spend time with their children to help them know the Lord; (2) One-on-one care of the YP; (3) The whole church needs to rise up to care for the YP every week; and (4) Annual meetings for the YP to pursue the truth together.



We have established a program called the Perfecting and Pursuing Program for the Church Life (PPPC). This is an informal program to assist the YP to have a taste of the truth and to appreciate the church life. The minimum period for participation is one month, and the maximum period is three months. We hope that this program can help the YP especially those who are in high school in this country.

Publication and Book Service in Kenya

We place great importance on the publication and book service for the furtherance of the gospel. The brothers serving at the High Peak Truths Publisher are working to ensure that:

- 1) Ministry books are available at all times for continuous distribution in Kenya.
- 2) Ministry Books are available to all the saints in the churches in Kenya.
- 3) There are channels to display ministry books in public areas (e.g. supermarkets, learning institutions and libraries in Kenya).

We thank the Lord for the ongoing fellowship to investigate whether it is possible to print books locally for distribution. Meanwhile we have received 147 books from the Africa Ministry Depot (AMD) Ethiopia on the *Crucial Revelation of Life in the Scriptures*. Saints are buying them for their own enjoyment as well as to give them out to their acquaintances.

The translation of the seven Rhema books into Swahili is going on well though we are behind on our schedule. We have done the first draft of all the seven books. In the final stage we hope to consult widely so that we can have a widely acceptable and high quality translation.

Church Life in Madagascar

Madagascar is an island state, approximately 400km off the east coast of Africa. There is currently one lampstand in Antananarivo. There are also saints meeting in Fianarantsoa, Mahajanga, Toliara and Manakara. A property was purchased in the outskirts of Antananarivo in 2020 and a meeting venue was built in 2021. Last October, 27 saints in Fianarantsoa were baptised into the Triune God. It was a wonderful experience for the saints.



In Antananarivo, a young student training meeting was held from 22-24 December 2021 where 40 young ones had a time of blending and enjoyed messages on "Shepherding for the Building Up of the Body of Christ". Many students genuinely received the word of the ministry and enjoyed it. We pray that the Lord will gain, train and equip many young people in Madagascar.
